- DUTIES:** Under the supervision of the Program Director of Plymouth AIDS Support Services, the Case Manager's responsibilities include the following:
- Provide transitional case management services for incarcerated and/or recently released individuals living with HIV/AIDS, including referrals to and follow-up with local medical providers as well as other services such as mental health, community support, substance abuse, housing, transportation, and benefits assistance programs;
 - Support individuals who are living with HIV/AIDS by linking them to and supporting them in maintaining a relationship with community providers;
 - Conduct initial assessments and intakes with new clients and develop service plans with these clients;
 - Support individuals living with HIV/AIDS in order to promote adherence to medical and behavioral therapies;
 - Complete reports and paperwork required by funding agencies;
 - Participate in required trainings and staff meetings; and
 - Other duties as assigned.
- QUALIFICATIONS:** Bachelor's Degree in counseling, human services or related field or other professional level training and certification such as an LPN or RN; 2-3 years experience working with HIV+ clients.
