TITLE: Home Visitors (5)
HOURS: Full-time (35 hours/week)
PROGRAM: Greater Brockton Healthy Families
BENEFITS: Medical, dental, holiday, paid earned leave, retirement, etc.
DUTIES: Under the supervision of the Healthy Families Program Director and/or Supervisor, the Home Visitor's responsibilities will include the following:

- ✚ Provide strength-based Home Visiting Services to first time parents under the age of 21 during pregnancy and up to the child's third birthday;
- ✚ Responsibilities include: assessment, advocacy, information and referrals. Bilingual staff may provide translation services for parents in the community (at medical appts., etc.)
- ✚ Serve as a role-model by giving support and encouragement to parents through strength-based teachings of child growth, development and life skills;
- ✚ Participate in group support services which may include co-facilitation, childcare, etc.;
- ✚ Participate in community outreach efforts and networking with community groups which may include the dissemination of appropriate material in strategic places throughout the community detailing the need for early prenatal care, parenting education, and prevention of child abuse;
- ✚ Participate in program related task groups;
- ✚ Participate in on-the-job training and site visits as required by Children's Trust Fund and Health Imperatives, Inc.;
- ✚ Maintain Participant/Family records and Participant Data System in a timely manner, in accordance with Health Imperatives policies;
- ✚ Be willing to work a flexible schedule including some evenings and occasional weekends; and
- ✚ Perform other duties as assigned by the Program Director/Supervisor.

QUALIFICATIONS

High School education or equivalent required, Associates Degree preferred. Ability to demonstrate oral and written communication skills. Basic knowledge of Microsoft Windows, Word and Outlook needed. Understanding of high risk behavior and cultural needs of the communities served. Bilingual/bicultural a plus. Must be able to lift and transport 20 pounds of program materials and supplies.
Travel is required. Reliable transportation, valid MA driver's license, auto insurance, registration and a safe driving record mandatory.
